Dear Ms. Feehan:

The Virginia Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) received your JPA/Pre-Construction Notification (PCN) on September 12, 2019, and the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) Nationwide Permit (NWP) 7, 12 and 18 authorizations on October 30, 2020, and November 13, 2020, for the construction of tunnel systems and infrastructure associated with the combined sewer overflow system. Because the project is authorized by the USACE under NWPs, and provided the entire project meets any required §401 Certification Conditions, a VWP general or individual permit will not be required for this project.

Should the size or scope of the project change, a VWP permit or permit coverage may be required.

If unauthorized impacts have occurred, you **must** contact DEQ within 24 hours of discovery. Email: vwp.nro@deq.virginia.gov. Any fish kills or spills of fuels or oils shall be reported to DEQ immediately upon discovery at (703) 583-3864. If DEQ cannot be reached, the spill or fish kill shall be reported to the Virginia Department of Emergency Management (VDEM) at 1-800-468-8892 or the National Response Center (NRC) at 1-800-424-8802. Any spill of oil as defined in § 62.1-44.34:14 of the Code of Virginia that is less than 25 gallons and that reaches, or that is expected to reach, land only is not reportable, if recorded per § 62.1-44.34:19.2 of the Code of Virginia and if properly cleaned up.
